6pm	Home time. Collection by parents at the Bridge. Earlier collection available if desired.

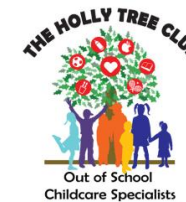
Please ensure your child has a packed lunch and drink and appropriate clothing for the weather, including sunhat and suncream and/or raincoat and warm clothing.
